Rationale and Scope

Sport is growingly becoming a key lever for public bodies and private organizations to address a wide range of social needs. The role of finance and private sectors is more and more relevant in view of promoting a higher impact of programs fostered by the public sector at local, national and international level.

In the framework of the <u>first Conference held in 2018</u> and of the <u>second one held in 2021</u>, the third Sport4Impact Conference will provide a dedicated environment to present recent evolutions, cases, tools and possible strategies elaborated by finance and private sectors.
